Jenni Awarded The Clevamama Splash & Wrap Towel 5/5

A great idea. My husband and I normally bath our baby together as we find it a bit difficult on our own. I was really pleased to be sent the towel as I was sure that it would make it far easier to bath my baby on my own. The website is very good and the products all look really good. They look well made and have obviously been designed with the baby's safety in mind along with how to make things easier for the parents. The website is easy to navigate and quick to load. The descriptions of each product are thorough. I really like the fact it was put in a Clevamama gift bag. I felt that care had been taken with my parcel. The packaging is easy to get into and the box clearly describes the product. I thought that the packaging could have been slightly more colourful. We have several hooded towels for our baby and I think this one is the best quality (despite that some of the others have a higher retail value). It is clear that it is well made and looked expensive. It is a very good size and I am sure that it will still be fine for my baby when he is a toddler. It is extremely soft. The fabric feels lovely to touch. I wondered if it would remain so soft after washing but it still feels just as good after several washes. I have absolutely no worries about using this round my neck. It is very secure and I have no concerns about it coming loose. It has been washed several times now and the fasteners are still just as good as they were the first time I used it. Instructions were very clear to follow. It was very easy to undo the fastenings even with one hand. The towel makes bath time so much easier for me and my baby loves being wrapped up in the towel because it feels so soft against him. Another reason that it is good is because I can put the hood over my baby's head more quickly than I can if I'm using a standard hooded towel as I've already got a hold of the towel and the baby at the same time. It stays just as soft as the first time I used it. Most of the towels I have for my baby don't stay as soft as the non-bio soap powder doesn't seem to leave clothes as soft as the bio powder does (but I need to use the non-bio as my baby's skin could be too sensitive for the bio) but I've not had this problem with this towel. It must be because the material is a better quality than my other towels. It is as it is useful in a few ways - safer than a standard hooded towel, keeps me dry if baby splashes, makes it easier to bath baby on your own and will be big enough for a toddler as well as a baby. This is good value for money as the retail price is less expensive than some other hooded towels I have and it is also a better product. I might actually buy another one in white or cream, so that I always have one to use whilst the other one is in the washing. I do have several towels for my baby but would be happy to use this type for every bath. I already have recommended it to my friend who has a baby. I think it is a brilliant product. Bath time is now much easier and safer now that I am using this towel.
